




But it's not just math...OSS is very diverse so there can't be 'cookie cutter' mentoring schemes.


Eriol's ideas*

Investment in the existing OSS designers mentoring so they can do it as part of a role!

Flaw: Who funds this? How? for what time?
For what kinds of activities?



Programmes like GSoC, Outreachy and new fellowships that focus on mentoring in OSS Design!

Flaw: Again, who funds this? What kind of structure is needed for designers and OSS?



Mentees mentor a mentee - pay it forward mentoring.

Flaw: When does a mentee feel ready to mentor? What if they don't want to? Is this inclusive?



Resources! documentation! Recording!

Flaw: Doing the mentoring is time consuming and hard...when will we get time to document?!




