Some Data ...

Elasticsearch (Elastic relicensed 2021-02-03)

- 1 yr before: 67 Employees >96% adds / deletes. 3 non-employees <1% adds / deletes.
- 1 yr after: similar results

Terraform (HashiCorp relicensed 2023-08-10)

- 1 yr before: 21 employees, > 93% adds / deletes. 2 non-employees: < 1% of adds / deletes.
- 1 yr after: similar results

Redis (Redis relicensed 2024-03-20)

- 1 yr before: 6 employees 28% commits, > 74% adds / deletes. 12 non-employees 54% commits, 12% additions, 15% deletions
- 6 mos after: 0 non-employees with 5+ commits

OpenSearch (Amazon launched fork 2021-04-12)

- 1 yr after fork: 7 Employees / >80% adds / deletes.
 2 non-employees <7% adds / deletes.
- 1 yr before LF: 40 Employees / >63% adds / deletes. 6 non-employees <13% adds / deletes.

OpenTofu (LF launched fork 2023-09-05)

- 1 yr after fork: 31 people at 11 companies:
 Spacelift, Env0, Scalr, Harness, Red Hat ...
- None previously contributed to Terraform

Valkey (Linux Foundation launched fork 2024-03-28)

- 6 mo after fork: 29 people at 10 companies: Amazon, Tencent, Huawei, Ericsson, Google, others
- 18 previously contributed to Redis
