



- I / the kids / the dog need more breaks.
- I want to take some time to explore things on the way.
- I don't want to arrive too late.
   Or have to depend on the last train of the day.
- And I need enough buffer!




#### These criteria are

- often more of an intuition than a true criteria




#### Berlin→Napoli, 4 different versions


via Verona, all in one (busy) day

#### What is "routing" in such a system?

1. Find "paths" from A→B (i.e. list of cities in which switching trains), can be pre-calculated offline.

2. For specific travel date, "fill" with connection data to get initial itinerary (might not be possible on that date).

3. Let user do the rest.



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- 2. For specific travel date, "fill" with connection data to get initial itinerary (might not be possible on that date).

Currently: Find earliest possible connection for first segment, then earliest for second, ... After all segments assigned, try shifting to later in the day until first train after 8am, avoid adding travel days.

3. Let user do the rest.

All the raw connection data everywhere :-(

Currently: I pulled data for Germany + select connections once and am pretending those are still valid and every train runs every day lol
