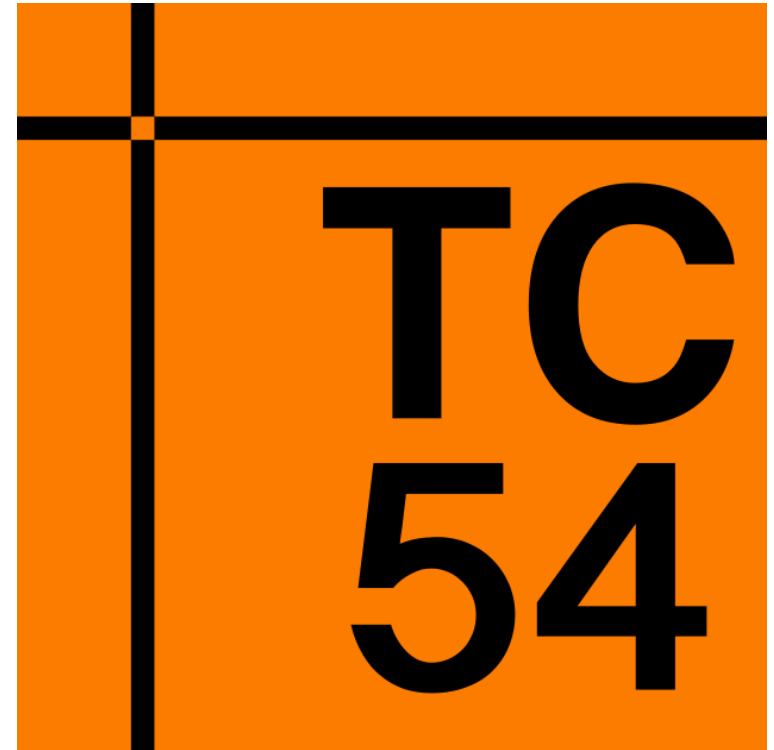
# Support *needs*
